

Dear Patient,

As you know, Polymyalgia Rheumatica (PMR) can be challenging to live with and to treat. That's why we're writing because your healthcare provider has indicated that a new clinical research study might be of interest to you.

The M20-370 clinical study is evaluating if an investigational medication could be a safe and effective way of treating PMR while removing the need for glucocorticoids (such as prednisone), known for long-term side effects.

We're looking for people who (among other things):

- Are between 50 and 80 years old
- Have experienced an improvement in PMR symptoms with prednisone and are currently taking prednisone
- Have had a flare (recurrence of symptoms) while tapering for prednisone

The study team will talk you through the requirements to see if you're eligible.

If you qualify and decide to join the M20-370 study, you would be involved for a little more than 12 months. This includes a screening period, a treatment period, and a final follow-up visit. During the treatment period, you'd visit a clinic every two weeks and be randomly assigned to take the study drug or placebo (an inactive treatment), but you won't know which treatment you are receiving.

All study-related medication and care is no-cost. You don't need insurance to join. Travel to and from visits may also be covered.
